TO ENCOURAGE AND PROMOTE ACADEMIC EXCELLENCE AND PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT IN THE AREA OF ENGINEERING FOR FAR NORTH STUDENTS

The Top Energy Scholarship Programme provides a one off \$10,000 payment for a Far North student wishing to study a Bachelor of Engineering (Honours).

The programme is for school leavers intending to study at the beginning of the year following application, at the Universities of Waikato, Auckland or Canterbury, and will cover relevant holiday work at Top Energy where possible.

Subject to successful completion of the relevant degree, Top Energy may offer permanant employment. This is an annual competitive scholarship which must be used to pay for tuition fees. It is a one-off payment of \$10,000.

The scholarship is open to students who have studied at a school within the area served by Top Energy's network, from Hukernui to Cape Reinga.

To qualify for the scholarship, applicants need to meet the following criteria:

- Be a New Zealand citizen or permanent resident of New Zealand and who normally resides in the Far North.
- Be a school leaver intending to enrol in a four year Bachelor of Engineering degree (Honours), at the Universities of Waikato, Canterbury or Auckland.
- Have achieved academic success (performed well in NCEA Level 3, IB or Cambridge examinations).

Candidates will be assessed on the following criteria:

- Academic ability based on your latest academic record
- Cultural and sporting participation and achievement
- General character
- Motivation to study and succeed.

Appl	ications must be accompanied by:
	A recent photograph
	A current CV (outlining academic achievement and any extracurricular science, engineering or technology activities)
	A copy of your latest academic transcript
	Details which demonstrate leadership and creative skills
	A signed endorsement from a referee
	A personal statement (no more than 1,000 words) outlining why you want to study engineering (or why you are already studying engineering), future plans on completion of this degree and why this Scholarship is needed

Shortlisted applicants will be interviewed by a judging panel and the successful candidate selected. There will be no further discussion once the decision has been made.

The deadline for your submission is 19 September 2025. The winner will be announced by Friday 31 October 2025.
